

Grace Greater than Our Sin (Romans 6:1-23)

1. Dead to sin through God's grace—the testimony of baptism. (Rom. 6:1-7)

- Baptism identifies believers with Christ's death.
- Baptism identifies believers with Christ's life.

2. Dead to sin through God's grace—secured by Christ's resurrection. (Rom. 6:8-11)

- As Christ lives so the believer lives!

3. Dead to sin through God's grace—demonstrated in Christian living. (Rom. 6:12-23)

Three necessary commands (Rom. 6:12-14)

- reject sin's domination
- don't submit to sin's power
- pursue God

Learn from the image of slavery (Rom. 6:15-23)

- Unconverted—we were slaves of sin and unrighteousness.
- In Christ—we are slaves to God!
