"REGATHERED WORSHIP" At the Park

Father's Day—June 21, 2020 **Two Options** (choose which is best for you)

- Regathered in the building 11:00 a.m. -KPBC Sanctuary
- Streaming Online-11:00 a.m. Available on YouTube, and the Church's website (kilbournepark.org)

What To Expect from the "Regathered Worship"

- 1. The Sanctuary will be "deep cleaned" and sanitized every week.
- There will be one Morning Worship Service in the Sanctuary. For the present, there will be no Morning Bible Study, Evening Worship or Wednesday activities.
- 3. If you do not feel well or if you do not feel that it is in your best interest to attend at this time, stay home and watch the worship service through social media.
- You are asked to arrive no earlier than 10:30 a.m.
- The church is not requiring you to wear a mask; however, it is encouraged. You will need to provide your own mask, if you plan to wear one. Hand sanitizer will be available.
- 6. You are asked to practice "physical" distancing when arriving on the campus. Be aware of concerns that others may have. Keep a distance between yourselves and others who are not members of your household. Please no hugs, handshakes or fist bumps.
- 7. Entrance to and exit from the Sanctuary will be limited to:
 - the front doors (which will be propped open)
 - the elevator that will be operated by a Deacon/Usher
- Nursery will be available only for children under the age of two years.
- When entering the vestibule, Deacons/Ushers (with masks and gloves) will greet and direct you to available locations in the Sanctuary. You may not be able to sit in your "usual" seat, as the Sanctuary will be filled from the front to the back.
- 10. Hymnals and Bibles have been removed from the pew racks. Please bring your own Bible. Also, all other printed materials have been removed. (continued on next page)

- 11. All songs and information needed for songs and information needed for worship will be on the projection screens in the Sanctuary. "Printed" bulletins will not be provided. How ever; an electronic pdf. of the bulletin will be sent by e-mail on the Friday preceding worship. You may print it out and bring it with you. Also, you may wish to bring a notebook and pen to take notes from the sermon. from the sermon.
- 12. The two basement restrooms closest to the elevator will be available. They will be cleaned after each use.
- 13. Offering plates will be available in the vestibule when entering or leaving. Thank you to all those who have continued to give faithfully.
- 14. At the end of the service, Deacons/ Ushers will assist in the order of dismissal from the church.
- 15. Please be advised that the Sanctuary building will be the only one opened on the campus.

Please remember to practice "physical" distancing until you leave the campus.


